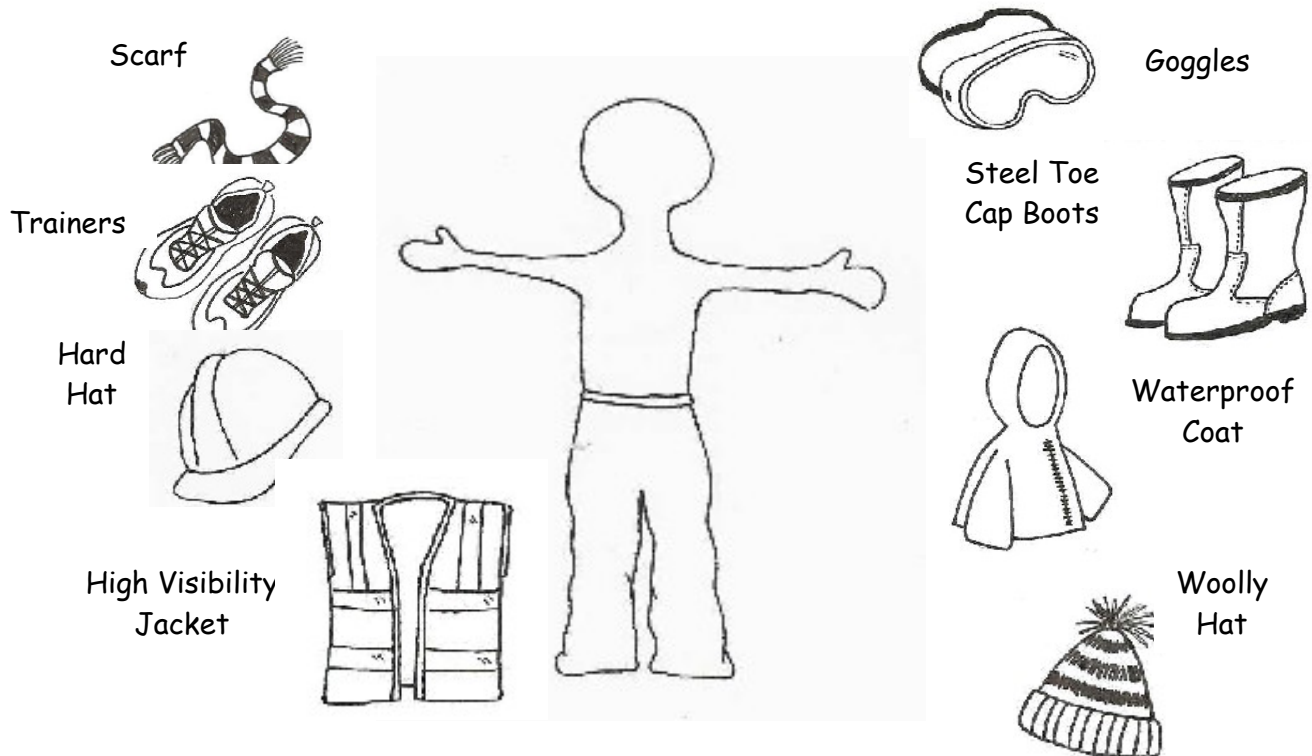
Working safely in sandpits
