

# Health and Safety Advice

The following points are offered as guidance only and should not be used as a comprehensive checklist.

Your local authority should be able to offer further guidance on request and the Health and Safety Executive may also be able to help.

- For any field visits for a pre-site visit is essential.
- Any fieldwork or activities should have full risk assessments carried out well in advance. There is a blank risk assessment template provided, which you may wish to use.
- The site risk assessments and activity notes provided by the Sandpit Project are offered as guidance and should only be used as a basis for your own assessment tailored to your particular group.
- Ideally two or more people should complete the risk assessment prior to the activity.

## Activity notes

This advice relates to the activities outlined in the 'extra information' sheets.

ACTIVITY	ADVICE
Sand Towers	A messy activity requiring some prior thought to location and staffing. Potential hazards include sand on the floor, sand in eyes, ingestion and plastic sand bags.
Sand Martin Board Game	An activity requiring a large space to work well. Potential hazards include slippery laminated squares and dice.
Role play clothing	Potential hazards include ill-fitting shoes and clothing.
