TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of an eastern part width of the Deadmans Hill Lay-By off the A6, comprising highway verge, at Maulden Wood, Bedford Road, Maulden, in the District of Central Bedfordshire.

IF THE ORDER IS MADE, the stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to The Greensand Trust by Central Bedfordshire Council on 5th June 2009 under reference MB/09/00517/FULL.

COPIES OF THE DRAFT ORDER AND RELEVANT PLAN MAY BE INSPECTED at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 6 NOVEMBER 2009 at Clophill Post Office and Stores, 4 The Green, Clophill, Bedford, MK45 4AD and Maulden Post Office, 8 Ampthill Road, Bedford, MK45 2DA and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State at the offices of the Department for Transport (quoting reference NATTRAN/E/S247/87) at the address stated below.

ANY PERSON MAY OBJECT to the making of the proposed order within the period of 28 days commencing on 6 NOVEMBER 2009 by notice to the Secretary of State, quoting the above reference, addressed to the National Transport Casework Team, Government Office for the North East, Citygate, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 4WH.

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it.
