CONDITIONS OF PERMIT/CLUB RULES

1. Comply with local byelaws (posted on site entrance Notice Boards at: Longslade Lane Car Park, Sandy Lane; above Aspley Heath; and Woodside, Aspley Guise).
2. Enter and leave site at authorised points
3. Consider **ALL** other site users - NOTE : pedestrians will be allowed to cross the "Play Area"; the Cross-Country Trails may be on existing horse routes.
4. Jumps and structures - only to be constructed within the designated "Play Area". Unauthorised excavations must **not** be carried out and no damage caused to trees and their roots.
5. Use only authorised routes over the **whole** site.
6. Carry Permits at all times whilst on site. Should a Permit be lost or mislaid, the holder must inform the Club; a £2.00 charge will be made for a replacement. Persistent failure to display the Permit may result in it being withdrawn.
7. Comply with directions of Greensand Trust Rangers.
8. Before cycling in the Woods, riders should ensure that the route is safe, they have the necessary skills and they are wearing helmets and other appropriate safety equipment.
9. Cyclists should satisfy themselves as to the suitability of Aspley Woods for them and their bike before riding.
10. All cyclists ride at their own risk.
11. The permit holder shall not engage in any race or trial on the access routes, and shall not cause any such race or trial to take place.
12. The permit applicant shall be responsible for ensuring that he or she is adequately covered by public liability insurance for use of the land under this permit. This must include himself/herself or any person using the access routes under a permit and include indemnity of at least £5,000,000. **A copy of the policy showing these details must be attached with the application.**
13. The permit applicant shall be responsible for ensuring that all permit users have seen and agreed the above terms and conditions.

I agree to abide by the byelaws and the conditions of the Permit, and only ride within the Play Area and on trails designated for use by cyclists.
