CONDITIONS OF CLUB CYCLE PERMITS – OAK WOOD

1. The permits are for recognised members of the named Club only and are valid only when used in conjunction with that Club’s insurance.
2. The permit holder shall be responsible for ensuring that he/she is adequately covered by insurance for use of the permissive cycle routes to include himself/herself, the bike, any person using the site under the terms of the Access Agreement and public liability indemnity of at least £5,000,000. A valid Insurance Certificate must accompany an application for a permit.
3. Cyclists must give way to all other users of the wood, including horses and walkers on all routes including permissive cycle routes and at all times follow any instructions given by Greensand Trust staff. *Do not put any other user in any danger. Be considerate of other users especially where the permissive cycle routes cross public footpaths and permissive horse routes and on the approaches to the wood where tracks pass private residences.*
4. The permit holder shall keep to designated permissive cycle routes and public bridleways within Oak Wood as shown by directions in the wood and/or marked on the official map.
5. The permit holder shall refrain from carrying out any digging or construction of jumps, or alterations of any kind to the routes without the prior consent of the Greensand Trust.
6. The permit holder shall clearly display a valid permit card at all times whilst using the permissive routes. Persistent failure to display a valid permit card may result in the withdrawal of the permit. *Should your permit card be lost or mislaid inform Stockgrove Country Park. There will be a charge of £2:00 for replacement of lost permit cards.*
7. The permit holder shall reimburse the land owner in respect of any damage (other than normal wear and tear of routes as a result of normal use under this permit) caused to the land, or any property on the land, by himself/herself or the bicycle.

We agree to abide by the above conditions and the byelaws and other regulations of the site.
